## Value their **story**.

- When you truly love people you desire to hear their story.

What questions do you ask to get to know someone's story?

- Connecting questions (open-ended)
  - Where are you from?
  - How's your day going?
- Be Consistent
  - Get their number
  - Follow up
  - Connect to their story so then you know HOW to connect Jesus to their needs.
- "Connect Jesus to their need"

Plant. Water. Repeat.

- Verse: 1 Corinthians 3:7
  - What serves as a seed?
    - Telling your story
    - Hear their story + connect Jesus to their story
- Be confident in the part that you play, whether it's to plant or water
- Sometimes your conversations don't get to the "GOD part" or "the Church part"
- Remember the goal
